Terms & Conditions

- a This tariff is available to catering, industrial and commercial customers who use gas for their business.
- b Payments must be made by monthly direct debit or other acceptable budget method.
- c The monthly standing charge for this is assessed on the connected load.
- d Our inspector will call on a regular basis to read your meter but we reserve the right to render an estimated account based on an assessment of your previous gas consumption in lieu of an inspection.
- e The Company reserves the right to require a Deposit to be held against charge for gas consumed, such Deposit to bear Interest at the rate of 4% per annum for each complete period of 6 months it is held by the Company.
- f The Company reserves the right to discontinue the supply of gas in cases where payment is in arrears, and to make a charge for reconnecting the service.
- g The reading on the Gas Meter shall be conclusive evidence of the amount of gas consumed unless it is established by test that the meter is faulty, in which case the charges in dispute shall be based on the result of the test or previous consumptions for the period.
- h Article 83 of the Gas Law requires consumers to give the Company's servants access to the Company's appliances at their premises during normal business hours.
- i Tariff agreements will run continuous and are for an automatically renewable 12-month period. If you wish to cancel the tariff agreement before the anniversary, this must be requested in writing. We reserve the right to terminate the tariff agreement if the terms and conditions are not met.

What should you do if you smell gas?

In the event of a gas escape:

Don't smoke.

Don't use naked flames.

Don't turn electric switches on or off.

Don't leave it to someone else.

Do turn your gas supply off at the emergency control valve (usually next to your gas meter).

Do extinguish all naked flames and sources of ignition.

Do open doors and windows to allow gas to disperse.

Additional information for LPG bottle gas users.

Do turn your gas supply off at the emergency control valve or cylinder valve or both.

If possible move suspected leaking cylinders into a well ventilated safe area, away from sources of ignition.
